Mr. Smith, from a select committee, reported the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Baltimore and Reisterstown Turnpike Company to construct, or contract to be so constructed, a passenger railway on the side of said turnpike, from the limits of the city of Baltimore to the end of the said turnpike road, or to any point thereon ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Bradley, from a select committee, reported the following bills :

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 17th section of Article 97 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to wild fowl, so far as it relates to Queen Anne's county ;

Which was read the first time.

A bill entitled, An act to extend the time of Alfred A. Duhamel, late sheriff of Queen Anne's county, for the collection of fees ;

Which was read the first time.

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Robert Goldsborough, late Register of Wills for Queen Anne's county, a certain sum of money improperly paid into the Treasury of the State ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act to amend section 48, Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Townsend, from a select committee, reported the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 152, 154, 155 and 156 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Worcester county, and substituting therefor sections defining the duties and regulating the pay of the wreck master for Worcester county, and his employees ;

Mr. Dashiell, from a select committee, reported favorably on the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act to amend Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to apprentices in Somerset county ;
