A bill entitled, An act to amend the 107th section of the 80th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, which requires the Orphans' Court to fix the commissions of executors in all cases, whether claimed by the executor or not, and to substitute therefor a section providing that where an executor shall renounce his commissions, he shall not be taxed thereon.

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 16th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto a section, providing a compensation to the Register of Wills of Prince George's county, for keeping the books of the school fund in the hands of the Orphans' Court of said county.

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Zadock Marshall, late collector of State taxes in Worcester county, an overpayment made by him into the Treasury.

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Treasurer to pay to Joshua H. Hynes, former Sheriff of Baltimore county, a certain sum of money.

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Asahel Willison, late collector of taxes of Allegany county, moneys overpaid by him into the State Treasury.
