

The Clerk of the House of Delegates returned the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore, Catonsville and Ellicott's Mills Passenger Railway Company;

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the State Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay over to Martha A. Lee, administratrix of Judge Z. Collins Lee, the salary of said Judge, for the quarter ending the first day of January, 1860;

A bill entitled, An act to renew and continue in force an act entitled, An act to incorporate the Maryland and Virginia Steam Packet Company, passed at December session, 1847, chapter 112;

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over Choptank river, at or near Dover Ferry;

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 180th section, relating to schools, of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws;

Which were severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

The Clerk of the House of Delegates returned the following bill, with amendment:

A bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, of Article 97 of the Code of Public General Laws, under the title of "wild-fowl," and to add the following sections.

#### AMENDMENT.

No person shall at any time shoot at or shoot any water fowl flying about their feeding grounds, or elsewhere over the water aforesaid, from vessel, boat, float, canoe, or craft of any kind, contrary to the provisions of this act; reserving, nevertheless, to any citizen of any counties, bordering on the waters aforesaid, whomsoever they may extend the privilege, the right to shoot from boats, other than sink boats or sneak boats.
