On motion of Mr. Lynch,

Leave was granted the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill to authorize and empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to endorse or guarantee the bonds of the Northern Central Rail Road Company to the amount of five hundred thousand dollars.

On motion of Mr. McKaig,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations, to report a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Union Bank of Cumberland.

On motion of Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to report a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Policy Coal and Iron Company, of Allegany county.

Mr. McKaig, from the Committee on Corporations, reported the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Union Bank of Cumberland;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. McKaig, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the county commissioners of Allegany county to levy for the use of Peter Staup and Daniel Staup, as administrators of George Staup, taxes erroneously paid;

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Peter Staup and Daniel Staup, administrators of George Staup, taxes erroneously paid by them into the Treasury;

Which were severally read the first time.

Also, reported favorably on the following bills :

A bill entitled, An act to authorize Samuel Swan to settle his account as guardian to John Hancock, and deliver over the estate to his said ward;

A bill entitled, An act to grant the leave of the Legislature to the Vestry of Zion Parish, in Prince George's county, to dispose of their interest in the Bladensburg Episcopal parsonage and lot in said county;
