

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal of the Senate, that had the Senator from Harford been present on the 25th instant, when the vote was taken on the bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Article 97 of the Code of Public General Laws, under the title of "wild fowl," he would have voted in the negative.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act to refund to B. F. Anderson, executor of Wm. Anderson, deceased, money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of the State;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claims of Joseph C. White, Sylvester Mudd, Samuel Hindes, George Jacobs, George E. Franklin, H. G. Letourneau, John Lindborn, James Wilson, Thomas P. Hambleton, Robert J. Jump, Joseph H. Skinner, Henry Medford and James E. Tate;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Treasurer of the State, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay a sum of money to John D. Ehlus, a private in the Baltimore City Guards, who was seriously injured during the riots on the main stem of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road, in the month of May, 1857, and appropriating the sum of two hundred dollars in full payment thereof;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for Tucker, Tongue & O'Hara, Nicholas H. Green, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, Levin Woolford, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, J. S. Inloes, John Clark, and Whitney & Cushings, for services rendered and articles furnished the State;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claim of W. V. Bowie, for legal services rendered the State;

Which was referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claims of S. S. Dawson, Charles H. Mann,
