

Rogers' land shall be delayed by any injunction obtained at the instance of said Rogers, his heirs or assigns, after the commencement of the grading or construction of said road through the lands of said Rogers.

Which was adopted.

Mr. McKaig offered the following

AMENDMENT :

Additional Section to be called Section 16.

And be it enacted, That should said company fail to construct said road, as hereinbefore provided, from its terminus on North Avenue to said Pimlico Meeting House, within three years from the date of the passage of this act, or fail to construct said road to its northern terminus within five years from said date, then this act shall be null and void, *reserving, however*, to all persons who may contract with said corporation the right to institute and prosecute all claims for labor or materials furnished, against the said corporation.
