

The errata on page 417, section 43, should read "the provisions," instead of "this provision."

The errata on page 463, section 42, should read "Insert 'not' before 'able,' instead of before 'to.'"

The errata on page 647, should read "Insert 'and' before 'suit,' in second line from top of page, in section 104.

The errata on page 676, section 242, should read "679, section 241."

The foregoing are errors in printing the list of Errata reported with the Code.

The following are additional errata :

On page 39, section 9, in the first line, read "assignee" for "assignor," and in the third line, after the words "unless the," read "obligee" for "obligor."

On page 649, section 110, in the seventh line, strike out "such and," after the word "in."

On page 364, section 50, in last line, strike "less than" before "thirty dollars," and insert after "thirty dollars" "or less."

In the Public Local Law, on page 350, section 66, in the first line, read "Monday" for "day."

On page 361, section 133, insert in second line, after "Maryland," "and return thereto he."

On page 437, section 49, in first line, read "seventeen" for "fifteen."

On page 459, section 188, at end of section, add "for election district number sixteen two justices of the peace and two constables, and for election district number seventeen two justices of the peace and two constables."

Your Honorable Body will perceive that the corrections above mentioned ought to be made on the reprint of the Code.

It has not the character of an amendment of the Code, but is merely correcting clerical and typographical mistakes, which every one would perceive in reading it. Such mistakes are common in our Acts of Assembly; frequently one word is written or printed when another is intended, and when this is obvious, the Courts interpret them as if the right word was used.

We have prepared a bill to carry out the suggestions we have made.
