A bill entitled, An act to amend the 77th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, by amending the 17th section, which provides for binding out children in the House of Refuge, by authorizing the managers to bind them either in or out of this State; the 18th section, which directs the manner of receiving inmates thereto, by authorizing the managers to receive the children of such parents as may desire it, and the 21st and 22d sections, which appropriates and directs the payment of a sum of money annually for the support of the House of Refuge, increasing such sum and extending the time for the payment thereof;
