

Rolling Road, of a width less than thirty feet, in the same manner in every respect as if said road was at least thirty feet wide; *Provided, however,* That said road, (unless with the consent of the owner of said property,) as to that portion passing through the lands of Gustav W. Lurman, shall be located outside of the water-ram and bath-house of said Lurman, so as not to separate the same from the mansion-house, or main dwelling, on said Lurman's property ;'
