Ordered, That five hundred copies of the bill entitled, An act supplementary to an act entitled, An act to provide for the instruction of youth in primary schools throughout this State, passed December session, 1825, ch. 162, and to encourage the education of persons intending to pursue the profession of the sailor, be printed for the use of the Senate;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Whitaker, from a select committee, reported a bill entitled, An act to appoint Trustees for the Little Falls and Forest Meeting Houses;

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Miles,

Ordered, That the committee appointed on the part of the Senate to visit the House of Refuge, be empowered to appoint a clerk to said committee, and he shall be entitled to such compensation as in their judgment is right and proper.

The bill entitled, An act authorizing the county commissioners of Allegany county to levy for the use of Elizabeth A. Watkins, a certain sum of money, for taxes overpaid;

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follow:
