

A bill entitled, An act to create a new election district in Allegany county ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. McKaig, Smith and Watkins.

A bill entitled, An act to allow Joshua C. Higgins, late Collector of State and county taxes in the 1st election district of Prince George's county, further time to complete his collections ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the trustees of the Garrison Forrest Academy, in Baltimore county, to convey a certain lot of land to the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in said county ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Constitution.

A bill entitled, An act to add the following sections to Article 2d of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to intoxicating liquors in the 1st and 3rd and 8th election districts in Anne Arundel county ;

A bill entitled, An act to add a new section to Article 1st of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to prohibit the sale of printing, writing and wrapping paper, in less quantities than a ream or section of a ream, within the State of Maryland ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Constitution.

REPORT.

The Committee on Education respectfully report, that they have had under careful consideration "the report of the Board of Trustees of the St. Mary's Female Seminary." They regret that they cannot favorably respond to the request of the Board of Trustees for a grant of aid from the State. The late period of the session before the report came into the hands of your Committee, and the exhausted condition of the finances of the State, would preclude your Committee from recommending an appropriation from the Treasury; your Committee would further state that they do not feel disposed to recommend the indiscriminate fostering of institutions of this char-
