And the Committee further report that the said E. S. Riley has entered into a bond, approved by the State Treasurer, to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned for the proper and faithful performance of his contract.

The Committee further report, that they have contracted with J. G. Taylor for preparing an Index to the Local Laws, and supervising the proof-sheets of the same, for the sum of one hundred dollars, and for indexing the public documents of the present session for the sum of forty-five dollars.

And the Committee further report, that the said Taylor has given bond to the State of Maryland, approved by the State Treasurer, for the proper execution of the aforesaid con-
