Petition to open a new turnpike road, referred to the delegation from, 112; bill reported to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Dulaney's Valley to the Little Falls of the Gunpowder, 395.

Leave granted the delegation from, to report a bill to empower the Commissioners to raise money to pay bounties to volunteers, 113.

Bill reported favorably empowering Jacob Resh to sell a lot of land in, 365; read second time, 450; read the third time and passed, 591.

Senate bill to change the place of holding elections in the third district in, read first time, 410.

Senate bill to amend the 193d section of article 3d of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Baltimore county, regulating compensation of the Sheriff, read first time and referred, 609; reported favorably on, read the second time, 617; read the third time and passed, 934.

Petition from the Rev. Thomas Watts and others, asking to be allowed to sell the old Cullison Church property in, read and referred, 570; leave granted, 626; reported favorably on, read the first time, 665; read the second time, 831; read the third time and passed, 923.

Senate bill to repeal sections 83 and 84 of article 3 of the Public Local Laws of, read the first time and referred, 657; reported favorably on, read the second time, 737; read the third time, amended and passed, 885.
