

BALTIMORE COUNTY.—

Petition of A. W. Goldsborough and others in favor of an alteration in the charter of the Baltimore and Little Gunpowder Falls Turnpike Company, read and referred to the Committee on Corporations, 660.

Petition of Mordecai Gist and others, asking a law prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors in the 5th district of, 726 ; read and referred, 726.

BALTIMORE, ANNE ARUNDEL AND HOWARD COUNTIES—Bill reported favorably on, to authorize the County Commissioners of, to purchase the bridge at Elk Ridge Landing, read the first time, 706 ; read the second time, 880 ; read the third time and passed, 957.

BALTIMORE AND HARFORD COUNTIES—Leave granted the delegation from, to report a bill relating to tolls on the Baltimore and Harford turnpike road, 75 ; reported favorably and read the first time, 102.

Petition against the passage of this bill, 181 ; reported favorably, 320 ; read third time and passed, 353.

Petition of citizens of, asking for the construction of a new turnpike road in said counties, 17, 18 ; referred to delegations from, 18 ; leave granted to introduce a bill, 27.

Bill to authorize the Commissioners of, to build a bridge across the Little Gunpowder Falls, between Jericho and Jerusalem Mills, and to levy a sum of money therefor, read the second time, 689 ; read the third time and passed, 753.
