

EDUCATION—

Petition of the Managers of the Maryland Institute, asking for a law accepting the offer of the United States, of certain land for educational purposes, referred to the Committee on, 314.

Report of the Orphans' Court of Prince George's County, in relation to free schools, referred to the Committee on, 370.

Petition to withdraw donation from the Bel Air Academy, and to appropriate it to Public Schools, referred to the Committee on, 375, 401; bill reported, and read first time, 460; read second time, 497.

Senate bill to add a new section to the Code of General Laws relating to schools, read first time and referred to the Committee on, 410; reported favorably and read first time, 460.

Bill reported back from Committee on, to add new sections to article 84 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Schools, see Ways and Means.

Petition in relation to Schools referred to Committee on, 63; reported favorably an act to add new sections to article 84 of Code of General Laws entitled "Schools," 101; read second time, 189; read third time and passed.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill assenting to the act of Congress granting lands to the several States for the benefit of education, 65.

Petitions of citizens of Harford county asking the withdrawal of the donation to the Belair Academy, and to place it to the common school fund, referred to the Committee on, 64, 74, 157, 360.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to provide for collecting school statistics of this State preparatory to the establishment of a State system of education, 134.

Order passed requesting the, to report some plan for the more equitable distribution of the school fund, 35; report made, 92, 93.

Authorized to report a bill for a uniform system of education in the State, 35; bill reported favorably and read first time, 391; read the second time, 561; considered, 819, 841, 842.
