

INSPECTIONS.—

Petition from lime dealers in relation to the duties of lime inspections, referred to the Committee on, 457; leave to report bill, 458, read the second time, 777.

Bill reported regulating the price of inspecting and cording of fire wood in City of Baltimore, read first time, 529; read the second time and amended, enacting clause stricken out, 644.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to repeal section 394 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore City," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to repeal sections 303 and 7 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore City," 571.

Bill reported from the Committee on, relating to the leasing of the State Tobacco Warehouses, read the first time, 572.

Bill reported from the Committee on, to repeal the sections in the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws of this State, in reference to the inspection of tobacco in the City of Baltimore, 572.

Bill reported favorably to increase the compensation of grain measurers of Baltimore city, read the first time, 574; read the second time, 777; read the third time and rejected, 870.

Bill reported favorably to repeal sections 303 and 7 of article 4 of the Code of Public Laws in relation to the inspection of fish in the city of Baltimore, read the first time, 574; read the second time, 748; read the third time and passed, 866; returned from the Senate amended, amendments concurred in and bill passed, 1009.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to regulate by law the measurement of charcoal, 662.

Bill reported favorably on to add a new section to article 96 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Weights and Measures, read the first time, 732; read the second time, 882; read the third time and passed, 991.
