Public General Laws, entitled "Clerks of Courts," to provide for pre-payment for recording deeds, &c., 185; read second time, 437; read third time and passed, 538; returned from the Senate endorsed "enacting clause stricken out," 1018.

Leave granted the Committee on the, to report a bill to make valid a deed from Elizabeth Gearhart to Joel W. Marsh, 186; reported favorably and read first time, 317; read second time, read third time, and passed, 416.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill relating to citizenship of persons who have been guilty of treasonable practices, against the United States, 186.

Petition of citizens of Carroll County, for an increase of constables' fees, referred to the Committee on the, 201.

Petition of Jacob M. Kunkle, asking for a law to require the Court of Appeals to re-hear the case of Kunkle vs. Fitzhugh, 201; reported unfavorably, 405.

Petition of Samuel M. Semmes, referred to the Committee on the, 201; bill reported to release the claim of the State against John M. Carleton, read first time, 405.

Leave granted the Committee on the, to report a bill to authorize Clerks to Commissioners to probate accounts, 363.

Petition of the sureties on the bond of Wm. J. Richardson, late collector of Charles county, referred to the Committee on the, 215; reported back and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, 290.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to release Wm. Price and others from the claim for taxes preferred in the State's bill in Equity in the Circuit Court for Allegany county, and to dismiss said bill, 217; read second time, 397; read third time and passed, 438; returned from the Senate endorsed "rejected," 579.
