Senate bill entitled "An act to add additional sections relating to the Superior Court of Baltimore city and the Court of Common Pleas in Baltimore city, to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, regulating the return of process and taking of judgments in said Courts, passed, 235.

Petition of the citizens of Allegany county for a law authorizing the sale of certain real estate for the benefit of the M. E. Church, referred to the Committee on the, 240; reported unfavorably, 244.

Leave granted the Committee on the, to report a bill to increase the constables' fees in Baltimore county, 241.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to give legal validity to bonds of conveyance, 242; reported favorably and read first time, 405, read second time, 567; read the third time and passed, 806.

An act to make valid a bequest of freedom by the last will of Edward Wright, of Dorchester county, to certain negroes, read first time and referred to the Committee on, 248; reported favorably and read second time, 290; read third time and passed, 335.

An act to make valid a deed from John G. Miller to Rachel S. Dorffert, read first time and referred to the Committee on the, 248; read second time, 405.

Petition against the passage of a law to sell certain real estate in Westernport district for the benefit of the Methodist Church, 287; report of the Committee on the, 405.

A bill entitled, an Act to make valid a devise in the will of William Gardner, reported favorably by the Committee on the, read first time, 290; read second time, 324; read third time and passed, 355.

A bill to amend 126th section of Article 16, of Code of Public General Laws entitled, Chancery, relating to the sale of real estate where the personal is insufficient to pay the debts of the deceased, 294; referred to the Committee on the, 294; reported favorably and read first time, 406; read second time, 487; read third time and passed, 601.
