

## ORDER.—

Directing the Committee on Claims to pay to Mr. McGarrigle one hundred dollars, 946.

Allowing the use of the Hall to Rev. James W. Hunnicutt, 702.

Rescinding former order in relation to the consideration and disposition of bills by the House, rejected, 727.

Requesting the Members to furnish to the Chief Clerk, the titles of the bills they intend to call up at the evening sessions, adopted, 727.

Directing Committee on Claims to readjust the mileage of the officers of this House, 727.

Directing that one thousand copies of the Constitutional State Convention bill be printed for the use of the members, rejected, 727.

Inviting Hon. Thomas H. Hicks, Montgomery Blair and Thomas Swann, to seats in the House, 116, 117.

In relation to the closing of the Journal of accounts, 550.

Forbidding smoking in the Hall, 570.

Instructing Committee on Ways and Means, to whom was referred the bill to amend the act of 1826, chapter 123, to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, to report how said bill will affect the finances of the State, also be instructed to report back to this House said bill for its action, 584.

In relation to hoisting the flag on the dome of the State House, read first time, referred to the Committee on Claims, 625.

Passed instructing the Committee on Claims to issue to John H. Shaw a certificate for a certain sum of money.
