

## WAYS AND MEANS—

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to pay Julia Gittings certain taxes erroneously paid, 88; reported favorably and read first time, 243; read second time, 312; read third time and passed, 327.

Senate bill to add a section to article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws, exempting parsonages from taxes, read first time, and referred to the Committee on, 323; reported favorably and read second time, 364; read third time and passed, 422.

Petition of Zenus Barnum and others, reported on unfavorably by the Committee on, 121.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill in relation to the collection of taxes on stock, 165.

Bill reported to repeal section 97 of Art. 81 of Code of Public General Laws entitled Revenues and Taxes, to provide for collecting taxes upon stocks of incorporated institutions, and read first time, 291; read second time, 398; read third time and passed, 440, 441.

Bill reported favorably to amend section 25 of Article 38, of the Code of General Laws entitled, "Fees of Officers," relating to Notaries Public, 188; read second time, 212; read third time and passed, 306.

Leave granted the Committee on, to report a bill to amend the Act 1799, chapter 16, relating to the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal, 203; bill reported favorably and read first time, 291; read second time, 397.

Petition in relation to taxing commissions of clerks, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, 215; leave to report a bill, 362.
