Ordered, That so much of the Governor's Message, as relates to a Constitutional Convention be referred to a Select Committee of five members, to be appointed by the Speaker, with authority to report by bill or otherwise;

Which was adopted.

Ordered, That one thousand copies of the Documents accompanying the Governor's Message be printed as a supplement to the said Message;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Trail offered the following order:

Ordered, That all bound volumes furnished members for their use during the session shall be returned, at its close, to the library, and it shall be the duty of the Librarian to collect said volumes;

Which was adopted.

Mr. McCoy presented the following order:

Ordered, That the Chief Clerk be authorized to procure such stationery, not furnished by the Librarian, as may be required for the use of the members of this House;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Jones presented the following order:

Ordered, That when this House adjourns it adjourn to meet on Monday the 11th inst., at 12 o'clock;

Leave was granted the Cecil county delegation to introduce a bill to repeal Section 134 and Section 135 of Article 8, of the code of Public Local Laws, relating to free negroes in Cecil county.
