RESOLUTIONS ON FEDERAL RELATIONS,

ADOPTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF KENTUCKY.

1. *Resolved*, That our institutions are assailed by an armed rebellion on one side, which can only be met by the sword ; and on the other by unconstitutional acts of Congress, and startling usurpations of power by the Executive, which we have seen by experiment can be corrected by the ballot-box. Policy, as well as principle, requires that Kentucky shall await
