

PHYSICIAN'S REPORT.

MARYLAND PENITENTIARY,
BALTIMORE, November 30, 1862.

Gentlemen of the Board of Directors:

I herewith submit my report of the health and mortality of the Maryland Penitentiary, during the past twelve months.

One hundred and thirty-six patients have been treated in the Hospital; and three thousand six hundred and forty-two prescriptions have been given from the office.
