Eight deaths have occurred this year.

John Hughes, white, aged 26, died December 11th, 1861, of Phthisis.

Theodore Ahrens, white, aged 42, died February 1st, 1862, of Dropsy.

Henry Williams, black, aged 35, died March 7th, of Phthisis. Adam Blythe, white, aged 76, died April 23d, of Cancer. Adam Hortig, white, aged 64, died May 29th, of Enteritis. William Coonan, white, aged 26, died June 18th, of Typhoid Fever.

John Button, white, aged 27, died July 18th, of Phthisis. Lewis Swaid, black, aged 40, died August 8th, of Dropsy. In the Female Department no case of disease worthy of notice has occurred.
