ticket and Henderson ordered us to take his ticket. He being a resident of Virginia, we refused to take it. Henderson said he was Provost Marshal, and he with the military obstructed the voting and so acted as to intimidate the voters. Your Proclamation and the President's revoke of the 1st article of General Schenck's Order was read and Henderson said that he did not regard it and that he and we should act under Gen. Schenck's Order. We as Judges signed the election returns as a matter of form, but think the election in this district was illegal on account of the action of the Provost Marshal and the Military preventing the voting. And we hope if it is within your power you will correct this wrong that has been perpetrated upon our people.
