Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill for the relief of defendants in action on official bonds of collectors of State taxes in Howard county;

On motion of Mr. Stevens,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill to repeal section 96, of article 81, Code of Public General Laws, in relation to the collection of taxes on stocks, and re-enact the same with amendments.
