

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to prohibit the granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager boer, at or near the Woodberry Factory in Baltimore county ;"

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading,

Mr. Lusby moved that the enacting clause of the bill be stricken out;

Which was rejected.

The bill was then read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 15th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the power of the Commissioners of the town of Rockville, by repealing section 66 of said article, and re-enacting the same with amendments ;"

Was read the second time, amended, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 41st, 88th and 89th sections of article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, 'Licenses ;'"

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate F. Knapp's English and German Institute, in Baltimore city ;"

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to ratify and confirm and make valid the action of the County Commissioners of Cecil county, in levying a special tax upon the assessable property of said county to raise a sum of money, to be appropriated to the payment of bounties to volunteers in the army of the United States, and to carry the same into effect ;"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to add new sections to article 16th of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, 'Chancery,' to provide for the care of property of infants or lunatics, by non-resident guardians ;"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
