A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal the 12th section of an Act to incorporate the Kent county Railroad Company passed on the 8th of March, 1856, chapter 148, to add four new sections thereto, and to appoint four new Commissioners in the place of four deceased Commissioners;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, "An Act to make valid the bequest of freedom by the last will and testament of Edward Wright, late of Dorchester county, deceased, to certain negroes;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, "An Act to make valid a deed from John G. Miller, to Rachel S. Dorffert,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, "An Act supplementary to 'An Act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference,' passed at the December session, 1839, chapter two hundred and eighty-five;"

A bill entitled, "An Act for the incorporation of Daniel and Jacob Lodge, number twenty-three of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend an act to incorporate the German and English Evangelical Luthern Congregation of Manchester, Carroll county, passed February 17th, 1862;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to change the name of Opossum Hill school house, in Caroline county, to the Concord school house, and granting the Trustees the privilege of moving the school house at Opossum hill to, or near Concord meeting
