

Strike out all after the word "act" in line 21 and insert "the commissioners of the several counties in this State shall be and they are hereby authorized to pay the bounties provided for in this bill to such persons as may enlist in the counties of which they are respectively the legal and recognized local courts, when proof legally authenticated is adduced to show that such person or persons did voluntarily enter the service, that no money shall be appropriated or drawn from the Treasury of the State to meet the demands of this bill;"
