Also, returned the following House bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to revive and amend the act of incorporation of the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, passed December session, 1823, chapter one hundred and twenty-five, with the several supplements thereto;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Female Samaritan Society of the Lutheran Church in Hagerstown;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to allow Henry Gantz, State Collector of State and county taxes, in Washington county, for the years 1858 and 1859, further time to complete his collections;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend section nine of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws for Allegany county, relating to the Circuit Court;"

Severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, delivered the following Senate bill:

Which was read the first time.

Also, favorably a bill entitled, "An Act to provide for the payment of the claims of Peregrine Gorsuch and Francis Gallagher, assistant Clcrks in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, under the administration thereof by Edward Dowling, late Clerk;"

Which was read the first time.

Also, favorably the bill entitled, "An Act to refund a certain sum of money erroneously paid over to the Comptroller of the Treasury by Henry Gantz, the late collector of taxes for Washington county;"

With the following amendment:

Strike out in line 5, "one hundred and ninety-one dollars and ten cents," and insert "one hundred and seventy-one dollars and forty-eight cents."
