Also, favorably the Senate bill entitled, "An Act to repeal the twelfth section of an Act to incorporate the Kent County Railroad Company, passed on the 8th of March, 1856, chapter 148, to add four new sections thereto, and to appoint four new Commissioners in the place of four deceased Commissioners;"

## REPORT:

The Committee of Conference of the two Houses of the General Assembly, on the difference of opinion on the amendments to the bill entitled, "An Act to provide for taking the sense of the people, upon the call of a Convention, &c.," beg leave to report the following as agreed upon by said committee of conference: The House will recede from its first proposed amendment, striking out all after the word "Convention" in line 31, to the word "provided" in line 61; and agree to insert after the word "provided" in line 55 of said 1st section, the words following: "however that at least sixty-five members shall be elected according to the provisions of this act, before said Convention shall organize, and proceed to business, provided further, that fifty members at least shall be necessary to constitute a quorum after organization;" to
