Also, favorably a bill entitled, “An Act to continue in force the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, chapter two hundred and seventy-six, for the relief of the families of Maryland volunteers, and appropriating a sum of money therefor ;”

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Waters, from the committee on Internal Improvements, reported favorably a bill entitled, “An Act to amend the charter of the Philadelphia, Wilmington and Baltimore Railroad Company, by repealing so much of the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, as requires said company in building a bridge over the Susquehanna river to provide for the general travel and transportation other than that by the railway ;
