

The Secretary of the Senate returned the following joint resolutions:

Joint resolutions for the appointment of a committee to extend to the Russian naval officers the privileges of the two Houses of the General Assembly;

Endorsed, "passed."

Also, delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend the fifty-sixth article of the Code of the Public General Laws, relating to licenses, by adding thereto the following section, requiring the Sheriffs of the several counties and Baltimore city to report an alphabetical list of persons required to take out license;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled, "An Act to add certain additional sections to article 4th of the Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, relating to mortgages;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize the Judge of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, to employ a stenographer, and to add a new section to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws providing therefor;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Stockbridge, Chappell and Boswell.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Frederick and Emmittsburg turnpike company," passed at December session, 1844, chapter 136;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, "An Act to make valid a deed from James R. Cushwa and Jonathan Loose, to George Brewer, George Feidt, Jonathan Hower and Jacob Houck, and also to William T. Peterman, Martin Luther Beard, Jacob Sword and Joel Charles;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the Washington county délegation.

Also, returned the following House bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to add a new section to article 8, Public Local Laws, entitled, 'Cecil county ;'"
