On motion of Mr. Iglehart,

Leave was granted the Anne Arundel county delegation to introduce a bill to authorize the county commissioners of Anne Arundel county to levy a sum of money for repairing a school house in district No. 7, of said county.

On motion of Mr. Douglass,

Leave was granted a special committee of five to introduce a bill entitled, "An Act to amend article 71 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, an act regulating the taking and catching of oysters within the waters of this State."

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Douglass, Frazier, Brohawn, McNeal and Tolson said committee.

On motion of Mr. Lusby,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill for the appointment of a wood corder at Canton, Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Stevens,

Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill to provide for the re-copying, re-binding and re-indexing the records in the office of the clerk of the court of Common Pleas for Baltimore city.

On motion of Mr. Greene,

Leave was granted the Allegany county delegation to introduce a bill to repeal section 9th, article 1st, of the Public Local Laws for Allegany county, relating to the Circuit Court, and to substitute in lieu thereof another section on the same subject.

Leave was granted the Harford county delegation to report a bill to add new sections to article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws for Harford county, relating to fences.
