bill to authorize the Comptroller to pay over to Dana Osmala, late collector of taxes for Washington county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

On motion of Mr. Masters,

Leave was granted the committee on Militia to introduce a bill appropriating a sum of money to pay the members of the Williamsport Guard, a military company, engaged in protecting the public works.

On motion of Mr. Gantz.

Leave was granted the Washington county delegation to introduce a bill authorizing and directing the Register of Wills of Washington county to revise certain indexes therein mentioned.

On motion of Mr. Boswell,

Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill to repeal the 853d section of article 4th of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to walling Jones' Falls, in the city of Baltimore, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also to introduce a bill to repeal sections 798, 799 and 802 of article 4th of the Code of Public Local Laws.

Also to introduce a bill to add to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws sections to confirm, ratify and legalize "an ordinance to encourage enlistment of volunteers in the city of Baltimore, approved August 9, 1863."

Also to introduce a bill to add to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws a section to confirm, ratify and legalize "an ordinance to provide for the defence of the city of Baltimore, approved June 18, 1863."

Also to introduce a bill to add to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, empowering the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to raise money and appropriate the same for the benefit of the families of those who enlisted at the call of the War Department, or those who may hereafter enlist, as a part of the quota of the city of Baltimore.

Also to introduce a bill to add to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws a section to enable the Mayer and City Council of Baltimore to levy and collect a direct tax, and to limit the amount thereof to twelve hundred thousand dollars annually.

Also to introduce a bill to repeal sections 4, 5, 7, 11, 13, 15, 16, 20, 25 and 26, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, and re-enact the same, with amendments thereto,
