

Mr. Stockbridge submitted the following amendment:  
Section 27, line 2, strike out "25" and insert "50 ;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Stockbridge submitted the following amendment:  
Section 32, strike out from "remove," in line 3, to "not"  
in line 5 ;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Stockbridge submitted the following amendment:  
Section 46. "Strike out this section ;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Stockbridge submitted the following amendment:  
Section 47. "Strike out this section ;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Herbert submitted the following amendment:

Section 46. Be it enacted, That the books of each warehouse shall be open to the inspection of any party who may have at the time, or shall have had previously any tobacco in said warehouse, and extracts from said books certified to by the chief clerk of any such warehouse may be taken by said party if he so desire ;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Carrico submitted the following amendment :

Section 25, amend 3d line, by inserting after the word pay, "in proportion to the amount of tobacco in each hogshead requiring reconditioning, from one dollar to ;"

Which was adopted.

The bill was then read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bill :
