A bill entitled, “An Act to add the following sections, relating to covenants in deeds of conveyance, to article 24 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to conveyancing and to follow section 71 ;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to make valid a deed from Chas. H. Carroll, of the State of New York, to William T. Carroll, of Washington, D. C. ;”

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Amend section 4 by striking out in lines 7, 8 and 9 the following words “greater than two-thirds of the amount of his bona fide deposits therein, which deposits shall be held as a security for the payment thereof ;”

Amend by adding the following section :

Section 11. And be it enacted, That the stockholders and directors in said institution shall be liable to the amount of their respective shares of stock therein, for all its debts and liabilities upon note, bill or otherwise.
