

The hour of 1 o'clock having arrived, the Order of the Day, being the joint resolutions requesting our Senators and Representatives in Congress to oppose a tax upon leaf tobacco, and appointing a joint committee to confer with the Secretary of the Treasury, and committees of Congress, and report,

Was taken up.

On motion of Mr. Lester,

The resolutions were referred to a select committee of five, to be appointed by the Speaker.

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Clarke, Lester, Waters, Lee and Westcott said committee.

Mr. Stockbridge, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably a bill, entitled, "An Act to repeal sections 119 and 120 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to auctioneers, and to enact a substitute therefor ;"

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Boswell, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably a bill entitled, "An Act to confirm the purchase of the Railroad of the George's Creek Coal and Iron company by the Cumberland and Pennsylvania Railroad company, and to authorize said company to increase its capital stock ;"

Which was read the first time.

The rules were suspended, the bill read the second and third times, and passed by yeas and nays as follow :
