1st. That the House to recede from 3d amendment, proposing to strike out the 3d section of said bill:

- 2d. The House to recede from 4th amendment, proposing to strike out the 4th section;
- 3d. The House to recede from 5th amendment, to strike out the word "of" to the word "any" in 2d line to the word "virus" in 3d line;
  - 4th. The House to recede from the 6th amendment,
  - 5th. The House to recede from the 7th amendment;
- 6th. The Senate to concur in 1st, 2d, 8th and 9th amendments, which are as follow:

## AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

- 1st. Section 2d, after the word "shall" insert "once in six years," and strike out "each bi-annual session of the Legislature;"
- 2d. Section 2d, insert after the word "and" in the 13th line "in case of death, resignation or removal;"
- 8th. In section 8th, 3d line, strike out all after the word "recoverable" to the words "the use" in 4th line, and insert the word "for;"
- 9th. In 10th section, 2d line, after "the" insert "first of April, eighteen hundred and sixty-four."
