

A bill entitled, "An Act to allow Alexander Woolford, late sheriff of Dorchester county and collector of districts Nos. 4 and 9 therein, further time to complete his collections of taxes and fees;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Frazier, Brohawn and Elliott.

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 420th and 422d sections of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled, 'City of Baltimore,' relating to the weighing of hay and straw, &c "

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays with proposed amendments;"

#### AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amend by inserting in line 22, section 1, after the word "section" the following:

"Or the commissioners may in their discretion sell the old scales and purchase and erect new scales at the new location;"

Add to section 1, at the end of the new section 422, of the Public Local Law, the following:

"And the inspector at the Western scales shall be allowed a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars annually for an assistant to carry out the additional duties required of him by this act, on proof that such sum has been properly expended by him;"

Add to section first:

"But the said scales shall be located at such place inside the city limits as will be convenient to both the Reistertown and Frederick roads;"

The amendments were concurred in, and the bill as amended, passed by yeas and nays as follow:
