A bill entitled, "An Act to amend section 143 of article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to offenders against the ordinances of the town of Hagerstown in Washington county;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 21st article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Washington county, by adding thereto certain sections, authorize the county commissioners of said county to endorse, or guarantee the second mortgage bonds of the Western Maryland Railroad Company to an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars;"
