A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal section 99 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery county, relating to the keeping and boarding of prisoners, and substituting another section therefor

A bill entitled, "An Act to empower the county commissioners of Montgomery county to re-open and adjust the claim of Elijah Thompson for damages on road, and to levy any additional sum of money that they may think rightly due him for damages as aforesaid;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal section eight hundred and four of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, 'City of Baltimore,' and to re-enact the same with an amendment, increasing the per diem of the judges of the Orphan's court;"

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend the fourth article of the Code of Public Local Laws by adding thereto certain sections authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to endorse or guarantee the second mortgage bonds of the Western Maryland Railroad Company to an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars:

A bill entitled, "An Act to repeal the three hundred and seventy-fifth and three hundred and ninety-sixth sections of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, 'City of Baltimore,' and relating to the inspection, weighing and measurement of grain, and to enact supplements thereto;"

Endorsed, "passed by year and nays with proposed amendment."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend section 2d by adding:

"If any grain shall be brought by water to Baltimore for sale in bags, the said inspectors shall weigh the said grain on board the vessel or steamboat without removing it from the bags, if the buyer and seller shall unitedly agree;
