Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Waters, Ecker and Starr.

Also returned the following House bills:

A bill entitled, “An Act to authorize the commissioners of Charles county to levy a sum of money to open and straighten Port Tobacco Run;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to change the place of voting in Myers’ district, Carroll county;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to incorporate the Maryland Annual Conference College;”

A bill entitled, “An Act granting certain privileges to the Fell’s Point Bank of Baltimore, incorporated by an act of the Legislature of Maryland, passed on the first day of February, 1862;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to authorize and empower Levin L. Keene, of Dorchester county to build, a dam across Keene’s ditch or creek between Lake’s and Hooper’s Island districts, in said county and to erect a tide mill thereat;”

A bill entitled, “An Act to incorporate the Gas Light Company of Cambridge;”
