furnished as hereinafter provided, and from the names of other voters in said county, who are qualified and liable to serve as jurors under the laws of the State, and to cause the said three hundred names;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Greene submitted the following amendment:

Section 1, strike out after word "county" in line 13 to words "and the box" in line 15;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Greene submitted the following amendment:

Section 2, strike out all after the enacting clause to the end of section and insert:

"That in order to assist said judges of the Orphans' court, in making the list of names aforesaid, the clerk to the commissioners of said county, shall on or before the first day of July next, after the passage of this act, and every second year thereafter, lodge with the register of wills of said county a certified list of all taxable male citizens of each election district of said county, and the said clerk shall receive such compensation for his services as the said county commissioners may think just and proper;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Greene submitted the following amendment:

Section 3. Strike out all after the enacting clause to the end of section, and insert:

"That the said Orphans' court, or some one appointed by them and their in presence, within thirty days and not less than twenty days prior to the commencement of the several terms of the Circuit court for said county, shall open the said box in the presence of the clerk of said Circuit court or his deputy, and the register of wills of said county, and shall draw one by one forty-eight names, or ballots from said box for the April and October terms of said Circuit court for said county, and twenty-five names or ballots for the January term thereof, and the persons so drawn shall serve as jurors at such terms of said Circuit court for which they were drawn, and the clerk of said Circuit court or his deputy shall make out a list of the names of the persons so drawn as aforesaid to serve as jurors as aforesaid, and shall file the same among the records of his office, and record them among the proceedings of said Circuit court.

Provided however, That in case any one should be drawn to serve as a juror as aforesaid, who shall make it appear to
