Allegany county, relating to the drawing and summoning of jurors to be arranged under the head of 'Jurors,' in said article;"

Which was adopted.

The said bill was then returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Griffith,

The rules were suspended.

Mr. Griffith submitted the following order:

Ordered, That J. Gideon Ireland, of Calvert county, have leave to absent himself from further service of this House, and that the chairman of the committee on Claims be and he is hereby directed to issue his certificate for whatever sum he may be entitled to as a member for the present session;

Which was adopted.

The bill entitled, "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to aid the Union Relief Association of Baltimore;"
