also of William Tod, and George Rumbly, and also of James E. Robertson of Dorchesier county, and also of John Stimmel;"

Which was read the first and referred to the committee on Claims.

A bill entitled, "An Act to add the following sections to the 81st article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the tax on Corporations;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled, An Act to purchase and enclose a part of the battle field at Antietam for the purpose of a State and National Cemetery;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Westcott, Trail and Gantz.
