So the amendment was rejected.

Mr. Henkle moved that the House do now adjourn;

Which was not agreed to.

Mr. Tyson offered the following amendment :

Strike out all after the enacting clause, and insert: That on Wednesday, the sixth day of April next, an election shall be held in the several counties of the State and the city of Baltimore, at the places, upon the hours, and, save as hereinafter provided, subject to the laws and regulations governing general elections in this State, and each voter entitled to vote at such election may cast his ballot bearing the words "for a Convention," or, "against a Convention," and the same notice of such election shall be given, that is required by law to be given of an election for delegates to the General Assembly.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That no blank ballot shall be counted at the election herein provided for, and the judges of elections shall not receive any ballot not printed or written on plain white paper.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the several judges of election to receive, accurately to count, and in due form, within three days, to return the number of ballots so cast "for a Convention;" and the number so cast "against a Convention;" and the judges of election in Baltimore city, shall make their returns to the clerk of the Supreme Court of Baltimore city, and the other judges shall make their returns to the clerks of the Circuit Courts for their respective counties; and the several clerks aforesaid shall make return to the Governor within ten days after said election, of the number of ballots given "for a convention," and of the number given "against a convention" in their respective city or county.
