REPORT:

The joint committee on Printing beg leave to report: That they have contracted with Messrs. Bull & Tuttle, in accordance with section 5, of article 76 of the Code of Public General Laws, for the printing of one thousand copies of the Laws and Resolutions passed at the present session of the General Assembly, with the index and titles of the same, on sized and calendered paper at least equal in quality to that on which the Code of Public General and Public Local Laws were printed, at the rate of one dollar and eighty cents per page of sixteen hundred and fifty ems. The said copies to be delivered to the State Librarian within fifty days after the adjournment of the present Legislature.

And the committee further report that the said Bull & Tuttle have entered into bond to the State of Maryland approved by the State Treasurer, in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned for the proper and faithful performance of their contract.

The committee also report, that they have contracted with George Gambrill, for the indexing of the Laws and Resolutions for the sum of one hundred dollars.

The committee further report, that the expense of the printing for this House, except the Journal of Proceedings, which is not yet completed amounts to the sum of seven thousand two hundred and seventy-six dollars and seventy cents, as will be seen by the account of the printers which is herewith enclosed and offered as part of this report to be printed therewith.
