The same in Somerset County aff'd The Jurors for the right hon'ble Jacob Crouch Esq; the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Somerset County aff'd upon their Oath do say & declare that Jacob Crouch Junr late of Somerset Parish in the County aforesaid planter the thirtieth day of October Anno Domini: Seventeen hundred thirty and five at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain James Wetherly in the space of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and him the said James Wetherly and there did beat wound and evill treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him then and there did beat the great damage of the said James and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Jacob Crouch Junr if fit to answer & make afterwards to with the eighteenth day of November Anno Domini: One thousand Seven hundred & Ninety five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Dividing Creek in and for the same County and the aforesaid Jacob Crouch in his proper person according to a certain recognizance by him and his security before acknowledged had a hearing of the Indictment aff'd who thereupon says that of the trespass and assault aff'd as by the Indictment aff'd aforesaid upon him imposed he is guilty thereof Whereupon all and singular the premises by the court here seen heard and fully understood It is considered that the aforesaid Jacob Crouch Junr pay unto his Lordship the right honourable the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the court heretofore imposed for and by Occasion of the trespass and assault aff'd whereof in form aforesaid he is convicted two shillings and six pence current money of Maryland and that the said Jacob Crouch Junr be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid
