Whereupon the said Jacob Couch Jur. is ordered to give Security for the payment of the Severall Officers their fees due by Occasion of the promises aforesaid. Thereupon a certain John Reddish of Somerset County Gentleman present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the said Jacob Couch Jur. and acknowledged himself indebted to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling good and lawfull money of England of his body goods or Chattell Land or tenements to be made and levied to the use of the Severall Officers that hath any right to any fees upon the Indictment aforesaid. If it happens that the said Jacob Couch Jur. do not pay unto the Severall Officers of Somerset County Court their Just and Rightfull fees upon the Indictment aforesaid &c.

appearances may be received to save themselves and their Security from a certain Recog-  
nizance before entered into — Whereupon the said John Deal and Thomas Blizard appear-  
ances are received and they and their Security accordingly discharged &c.

Whereupon the said John Deal and Thomas Blizard are ordered to give Security for their good behaviour and appearance at March Court Next &c.

Thereupon the said John Deal with Joseph Gray of Somerset County planter both <sup>his Security</sup> present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in thirty pounds Sterling good and lawfull money of England of their goods and Chattell Land and tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happens that the said John Deal do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividine Creek in and for the same County the third Tuesday of March next and do not answer unto his Lordship of and concerning such things as shall be then and there objected against him on his Lordship's behalf and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave and in the meantime if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people then &c.
